RESOLUTION NO. 2023–12-02 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE SERENITY RIDGE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT NO. 1 TO ADOPT THE 2024 BUDGET AND APPROPRIATE SUMS OF MONEY

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Serenity Ridge Metropolitan District No. 1 ("District") has appointed the District Accountant to prepare and submit a proposed 2024 budget to the Board at the proper time; and

WHEREAS, the District Accountant has submitted a proposed budget to this Board on or before October 15, 2023, for its consideration; and

WHEREAS, upon due and proper notice, published or posted in accordance with the law, said proposed budget was open for inspection by the public at a designated place, a public hearing was held on December 7, 2023, and interested electors were given the opportunity to file or register any objections to said proposed budget; and

WHEREAS, the budget has been prepared to comply with all terms, limitations and exemptions, including, but not limited to, reserve transfers and expenditure exemptions, under Article X, Section 20 of the Colorado Constitution ("TABOR") and other laws or obligations which are applicable to or binding upon the District; and

WHEREAS, whatever increases may have been made in the expenditures, like increases were added to the revenues so that the budget remains in balance, as required by law.

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the District has made provisions therein for revenues in an amount equal to or greater than the total proposed expenditures as set forth in said budget; and

WHEREAS, it is not only required by law, but also necessary to appropriate the revenues provided in the budget to and for the purposes described below, as more fully set forth in the budget, including any interfund transfers listed therein, so as not to impair the operations of the District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Serenity Ridge Metropolitan District No. 1:

1. That the budget as submitted, amended, and summarized by fund, hereby is approved and adopted as the budget of the Serenity Ridge Metropolitan District No. 1 for the 2024 fiscal year.

2. That the budget, as hereby approved and adopted, shall be certified by the Secretary of the District to all appropriate agencies and is made a part of the public records of the District.

3. That the sums set forth as the total expenditures of each fund in the budget attached hereto as **EXHIBIT A** and incorporated herein by reference are hereby appropriated from the revenues of each fund, within each fund, for the purposes stated.

2024 Budget Message

Introduction

Serenity Ridge Metropolitan District No. 1 ("District No. 1") was formed in 2004 for the purpose of providing design, financing, acquisition, and construction of certain infrastructure including water improvements, street improvements, sanitary sewer improvements, park and recreation improvements and traffic and safety controls. When appropriate, these improvements have been dedicated to the City of Aurora, or such other entities as appropriate for the use and benefit of the District taxpayers and service users. Pursuant to an April, 2004 "Facilities Construction and Service Agreement with Serenity Ridge Metropolitan District No. 2 ("District No. 2"), District No. 1 has been designated the "Operating" District and District No. 2, the "Taxing" District.

The 2024 budget was prepared in accordance with the Local Budget Law of Colorado. The budget reflects the projected spending plan for the 2024 fiscal year based on available revenues. This budget provides for the general operation of the District. The District is dependent upon a transfer from District No. 2 to be able to meet these obligations.

The District's 2023 assessed value is \$956,199 an increase from \$834,046 the previous year. The District has chosen not to certify a mill levy for taxes collected in 2024.

Budgetary Basis of Accounting

The District uses funds to budget and report on the financial position and results of operations. Fund accounting is designed to demonstrate legal compliance and to aid financial management by segregating transactions related to certain governmental functions. The various funds determine the total District budget. All of the District's funds are considered governmental funds and are reported using the current financial resources and the modified accrual basis of accounting. Revenues are recognized when they are measurable and available. Revenues are considered available when they are collectible within the current period. For this purpose, the District considers revenues to be available if they are collected within 60-days of the end of the current fiscal period. Expenditures, other than the interest on long term obligations, are recorded when the liability is incurred or the long-term obligation paid.

Fund Summaries

The **General Fund** is used to account for resources traditionally associated with government such as property taxes, specific ownership tax and expenditures which include district administration, legal services, and other expenses related to statutory operations of a local government. The primary sources of revenue in 2024 is a transfer from District No. 2.

Emergency Reserve

As required by Section 20 of Article X of the Colorado Constitution ("TABOR"), the District has provided for an Emergency Reserve in the amount of 3% of the total fiscal year revenue in the General Fund.

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-12-03 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE SERENITY RIDGE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT NO. 1 TO SET MILL LEVIES

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Serenity Ridge Metropolitan District No. 1 ("District") has adopted the 2024 annual budget in accordance with the Local Government Budget Law on December 7, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the adopted budget is attached to the Resolution of the Board of Directors to Adopt the 2024 Budget and Appropriate Sums of Money, and such budget is incorporated herein by this reference; and

WHEREAS, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for general fund expenses from property tax revenue is identified in the budget; and

WHEREAS, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for debt service fund expenses from property tax revenue is identified in the budget; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of Serenity Ridge Metropolitan District No. 1:

1. That for the purposes of meeting all general fund expenses of the District during the 2024 budget year, the District determined to levy mills upon each dollar of the total valuation for assessment of all taxable property within the District, as set forth in the budget, to raise the required revenue.

2. That for the purposes of meeting all debt service fund expenses of the District during the 2024 budget year, the District determined to levy mills upon each dollar of the total valuation for assessment of all taxable property within the District, as set forth in the budget, to raise the required revenue.

3. That the District Accountant of the District is hereby authorized and directed to immediately certify to the County Commissioners of Arapahoe County, Colorado, the mill levies for the District as set forth in the District's Certification of Tax Levies (attached hereto as **EXHIBIT A** and incorporated herein by reference), recalculated as needed upon receipt of the final certification of valuation from the County Assessor in order to comply with any applicable revenue and other budgetary limits.
